## The Challenge

JDE's liquid coffee is a popular product for large companies around New Zealand. It's costeffective and high quality. For JDE, it's important that their customers receive the product in excellent condition. Previously, they've used Poly bins to transport this product to their customers. The bins are sturdy, and hold the temperature of the coffee well. However, they came with a few significant downsides:

- 1. No sustainable recycling option;
- 2. Huge amount of storage space needed; and
- 3. Time cost

  (JDE reps had to spend extra time picking up the bins from their customers once they were used.)

#### The Solution
